#### Travel planning and booking

#### Payment arrangements

With the confirmation of your cruise, you will receive an invoice for a deposit. The deposit is 25 % of the total amount. You will receive the final invoice approximately four weeks before the start of your journey. Payment is due immediately.

#### <u>Insurance</u>

The liability of the shipping companies is limited. The regulations of the relevant shipping company apply. A health insurance for abroad with return transport to your home country is mandatory. You may obtain relevant information material about insurances from your travel agency Hamburg Süd Reiseagentur GmbH.

#### **Travel documents**

Once the payment has been received, we will send you your ticket as well as all other travel documents approximately 10 days before the scheduled start of your journey.

#### Passport and visa regulations

The requirements for passports and visa depend on the travel route. The traveller is personally responsible for the compliance with the formalities. The visa references stated in our respective travel descriptions are merely non-binding information. For binding visa information, you may contact the relevant Embassy or Consulate of the respective countries.

#### <u>Language</u>

At any rate, knowledge of the English language is advantageous, as people of the ship's company are of different nationalities.

#### Health regulations

The health regulations depend on the travel route. The traveller is personally responsible for the compliance with the formalities and should get informed early about infection protection and protection by vaccination as well as any other prophylactic measures.
